You should include a link to a short video, lasting no more than five minutes, that we can view online (on YouTube or similar). It doesn't need to be high tech or professionally produced, you could film it on your mobile phone, but it should show us some of your creative and performing talents. It could be a teaser/trailer for your show or a performance about your company. The style and content are up to you.

CRITERIA

- Open to early career performers based in Kent
- Applications welcome from solo acts, duos and companies
- Individuals or companies need to be operating (or starting to operate) professionally
- Successful applicants should have public liability insurance cover
- Year One will reimburse rehearsal, travel, accommodation, registration and/or publicity expenses up to £1000 on production of receipts
